

TAMAN TUMBINA BINTULU ialah integrasi sebuah taman tumbuhan dengan sebuah taman haiwan. Perkataan TUMBINA ialah gabungan perkataan-perkataan TUMbuhan dan BINAtang.

Dibuka dengan rasminya pada 2 Ogos 1991, TUMBINA menyediakan satu imbasan kepelbagaiannya flora dan fauna Sarawak. Ia merupakan satu warisan dengan nilai-nilai pendidikan dan rekreasi untuk para pelawat daripada semua lapisan masyarakat.

TUMBINA berkeluasan kira-kira 57 hektar dan berbukit-bukau. Kedudukannya yang berhampiran dengan Laut China Selatan, di antara pusat Bandar Bintulu dan Kawasan Perindustrian Tanjung Kidurong membuatkannya sebagai satu kawasan yang amat strategik untuk menikmati pemandangan dan keindahan Bintulu.

Sebagai Yang Pertama Seumpamanya Di Bumi Kenyalang, TUMBINA merupakan satu tempat yang istimewa dan mesti dilawati apabila anda berada di Bintulu.

TAMAN TUMBINA BINTULU is an integration of a botanical garden and zoological garden. The name TUMBINA originates from the malay words TUMbuhan (plant) and BINAtang (animal).

Officially opened 2 August 1991, TUMBINA provides a glimpse of the diverse flora and fauna of Sarawak. It is a living heritage with both recreational and educational values for visitor from all walks of life.

Spreading over a hilly and undulating terrain of 57 hectares, TUMBINA is strategically situated on a breathtaking site overlooking the South China Sea, Bintulu town centre and Tanjung Kidurong Industrial Estate.

Being *The First Of Its Kind In The Land Of The Hornbill*, TUMBINA is a unique attraction and a must-visit place whenever you are in Bintulu.



MAJOR ATTRACTIONS

Alam Kelebar is the local Malay term for Butterfly World. It encompasses a specially designed enclosure with beautiful landscape and greenery. On display are both live and preserved butterflies.

Orchid Collection is the biggest collection of orchids within the northern region of Sarawak.

Reptile Complex is where you have the opportunity to glimpse through the world of reptiles. Exhibited are the crocodiles, tortoises and pythons

Spring Garden is a collection of annuals and perennials flowers that bloom in myriad of colours throughout the year. It is located adjacent to the Succulent Collection.

Hornbill Collection at Tumbina is the largest collection in term of number of species exhibited at any one time in this part of Sarawak.

The **Tiger**, is the only pair in Sarawak. Both are born and bred in Tumbina.

The **Greater Flamingo**, specially brought in from Tanzania in 1991, is the only collection of this species in Sarawak. Breeding wise, it's a success story. Presently, more than 7 birds were bred in Tumbina.
